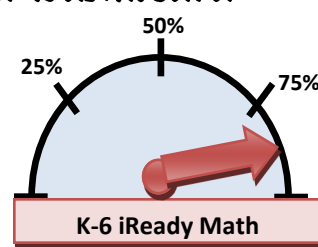

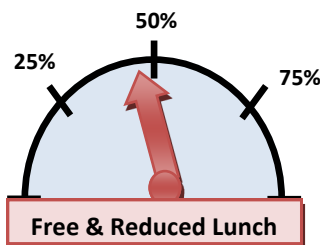
Average % At, Above & One Grade Level Below Diagnostic 1/Diagnostic 2

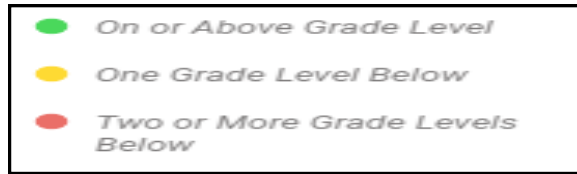
% of Students Joining the Military, Workforce, Attending College

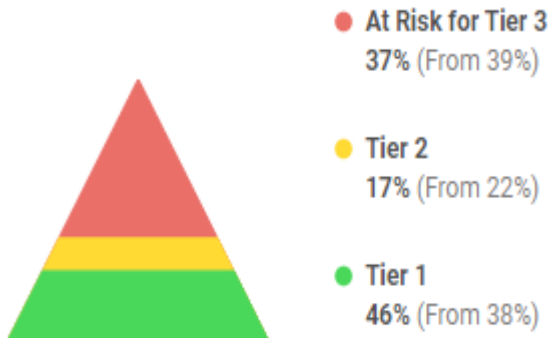




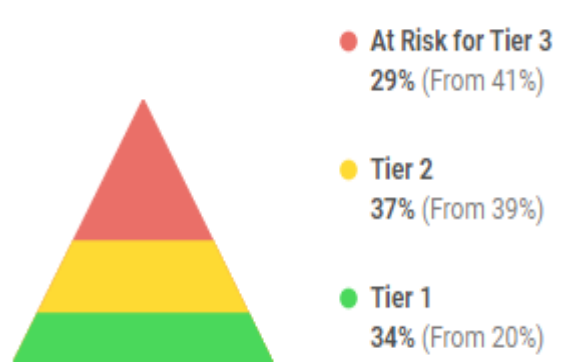
Grade 6 i-Ready Growth from Diagnostic 1 to Diagnostic 2

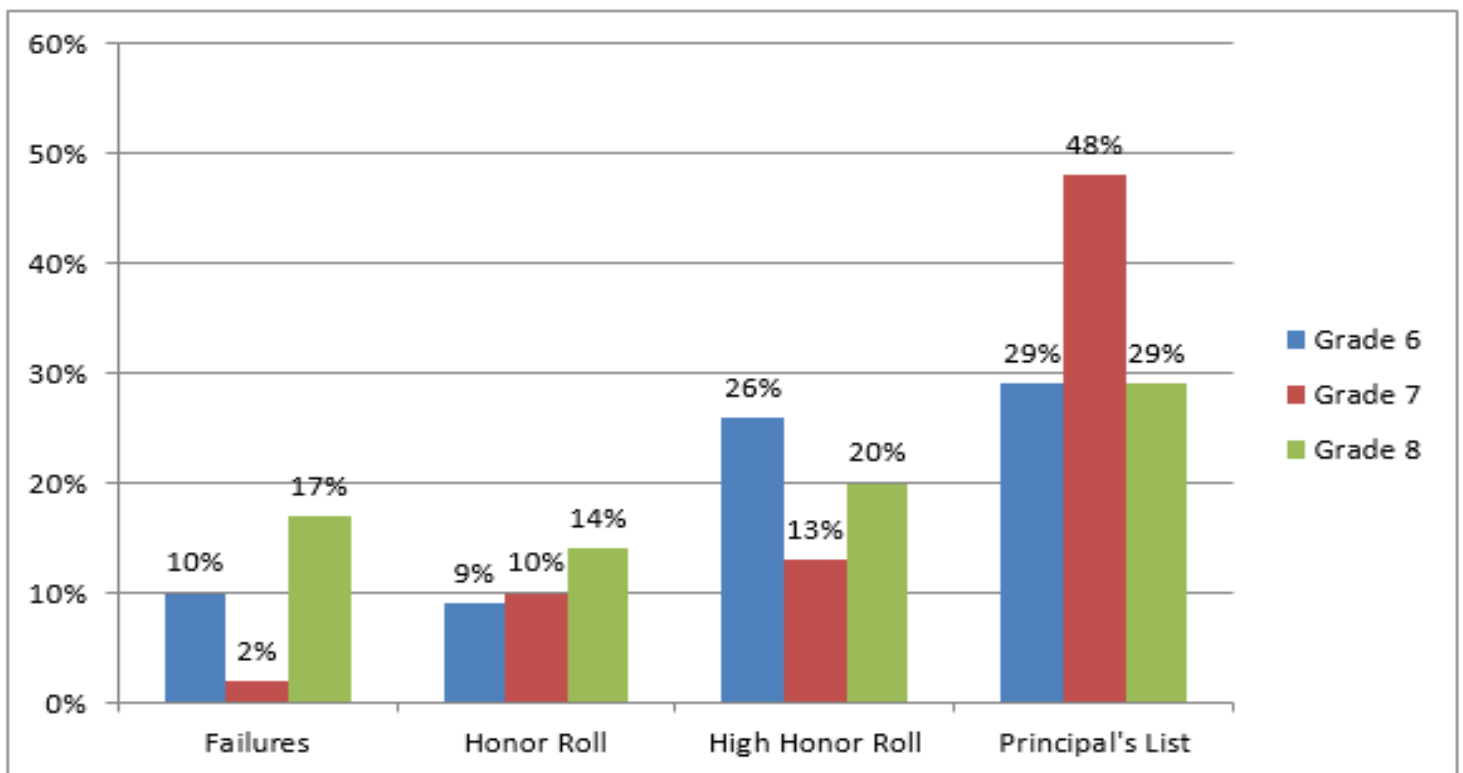

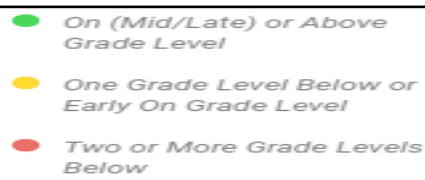
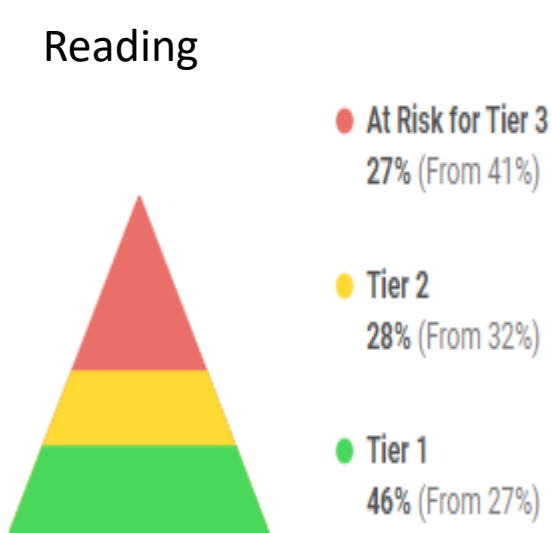
% of Students: Principal's List, High Honor, Honor Roll and Failing



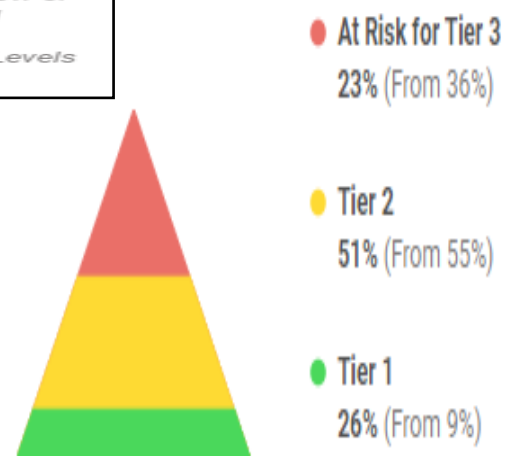


i-Ready Growth from Diagnostic 1 to Diagnostic 2 as a Building

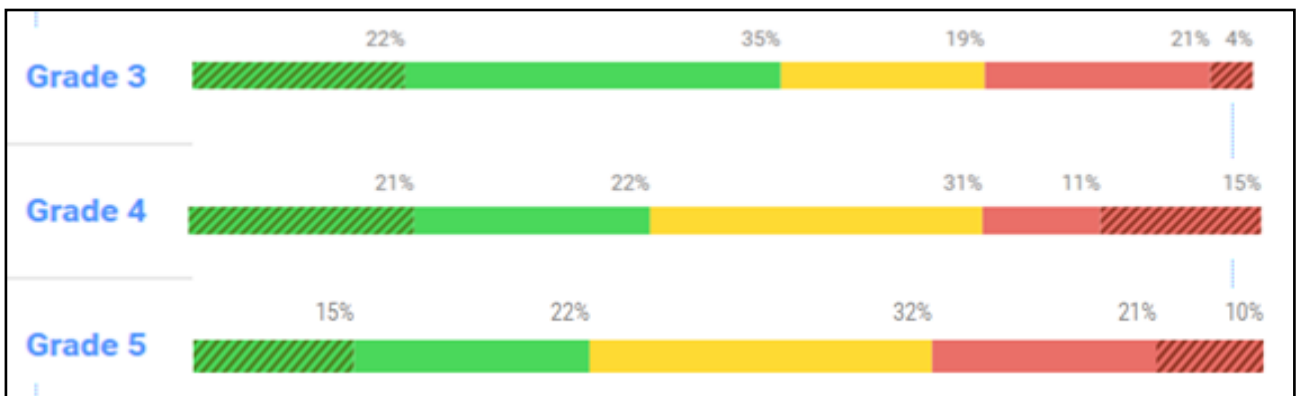

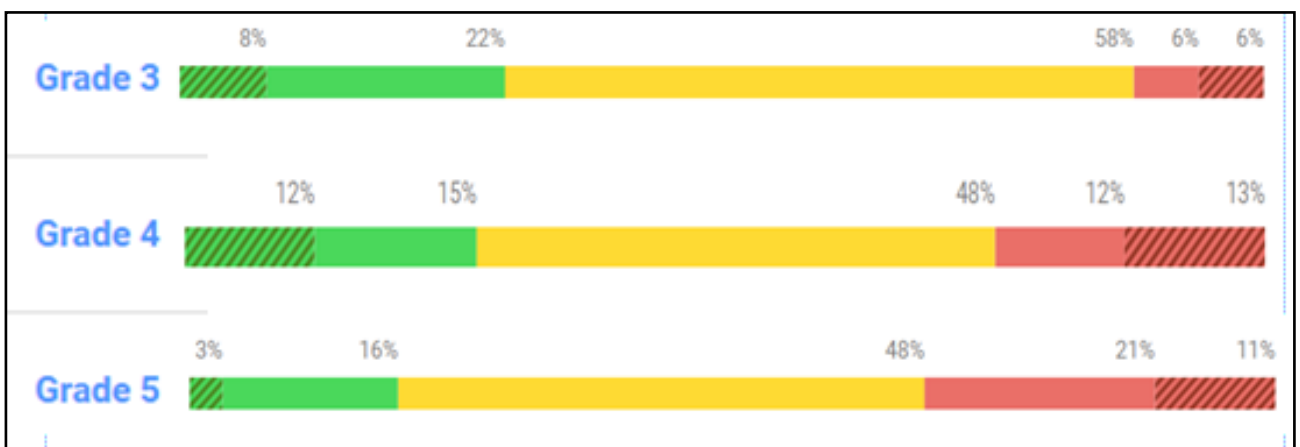
i-Ready: Percentage of Students At or Above Grade Level Using 5-Level Placement as of February

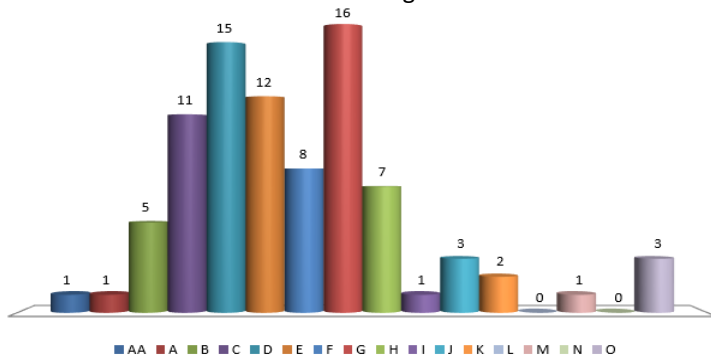

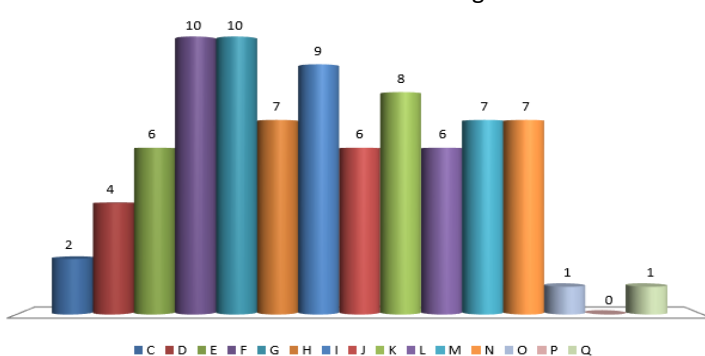

Grade 1 Instructional Reading Levels– Winter

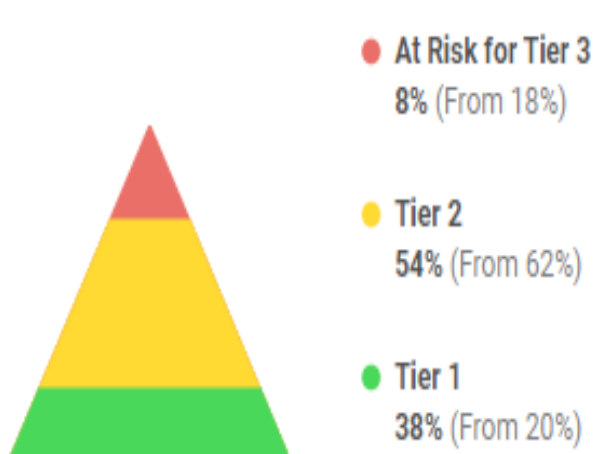


Grade 2 Instructional Reading Levels– Winter

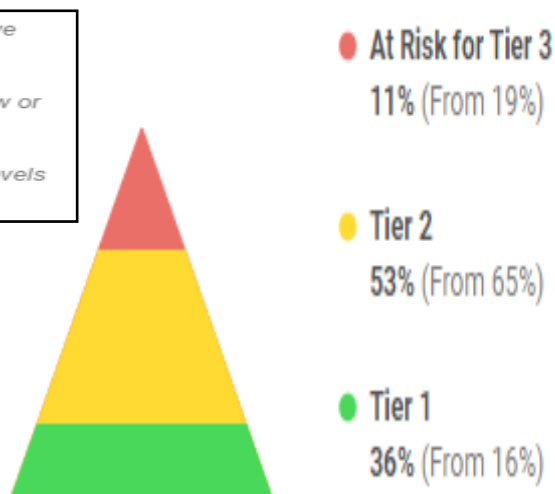


iReady Data: Percent of Students At or Above Grade Level as a Building

Reading Data: Diagnostic 1 to Diagnostic 2



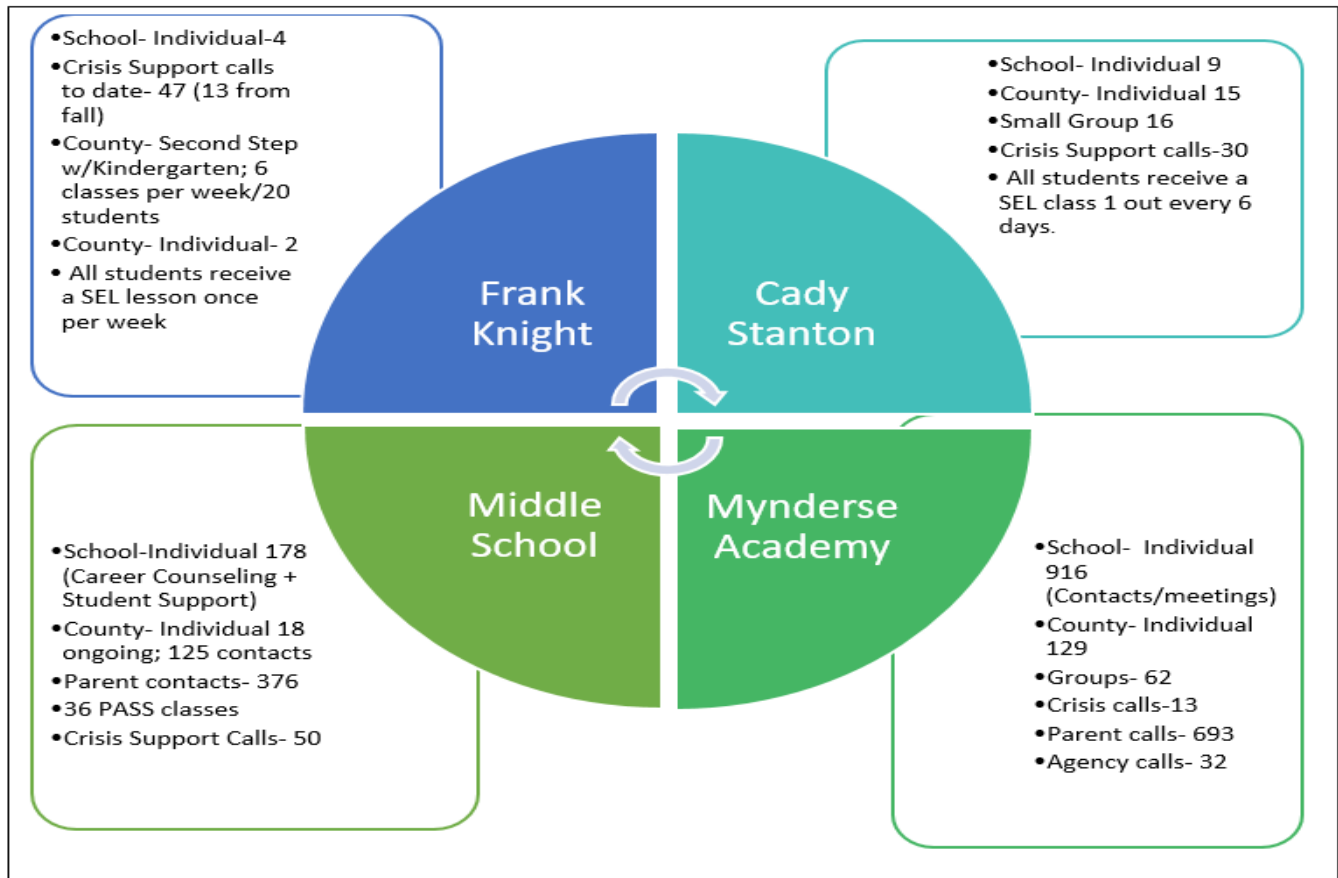
Math Data: Diagnostic 1 to Diagnostic 2





COUNSELING SERVICES K-12

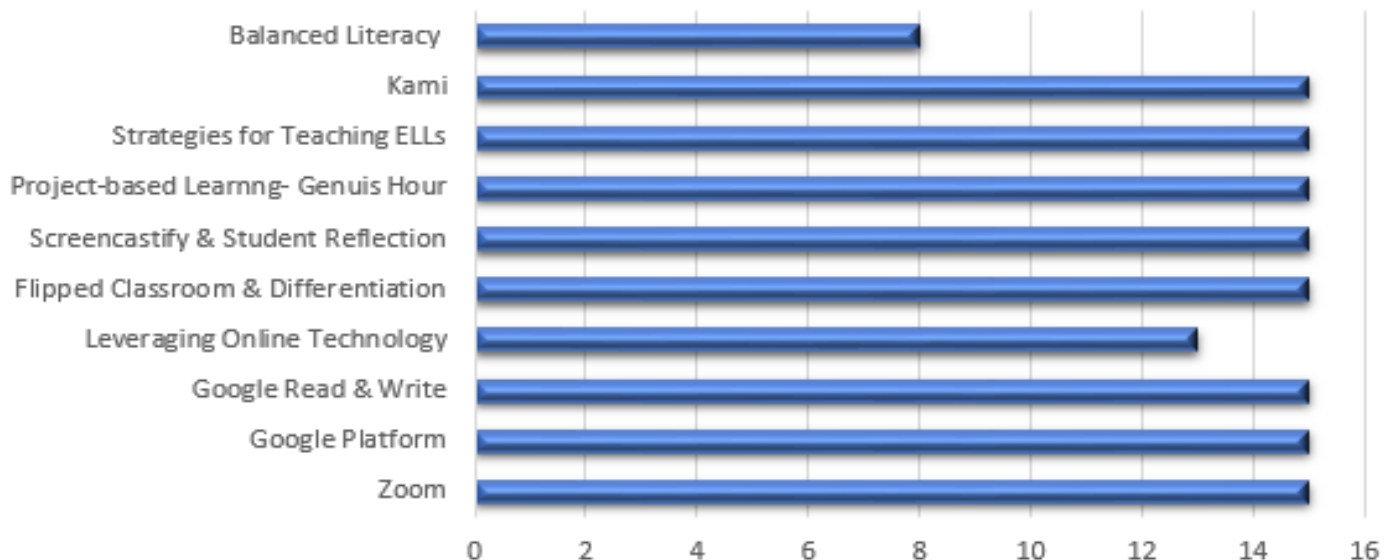

Attendance Rates as of February 27, 2021

Students receive attendance credit by connecting to classes in-person, remotely or by completing work during a quarantined period determined by the DOH. Interventions such as teacher phone calls, counselor phone calls, counselor & SRO home visits, principal phone calls, and creation of student success action plans are examples of the District's efforts to support students' engagement, resulting in the student receiving attendance credit. This is an ongoing effort. All students attending & engaging is a long standing goal of SFCSD.
