
## CHRISTOPHER M. DRAGONE CLASS OF 2002



Christopher was an outstanding athlete during his high school career, earning varsity letters in cross country, track and field, basketball, and tennis. A strong leader and motivator of his teammates, Christopher also served as captain of the cross country, track and field, and basketball teams.

Christopher excelled as a distance runner, achieving great success and receiving many accolades. In cross country, Christopher was a four-time state meet qualifier, three-time sectional champion, and league champion. He earned All-League and All-Section V recognition on

numerous occasions. In track and field, Christopher was a three-time state meet qualifier (3200M twice and 1600M once), seven-time sectional champion (3200M three times, 1600M twice, and 4 x 800M relay twice), and league champion in the same events. He also earned All-League and All-Section V recognition on numerous occasions. In his senior year, Christopher was undefeated in the league in both cross country and track. He is the school record holder in both the 1600M and 3200M events.

Christopher also participated in varsity basketball, starting at point guard during his junior and senior years, and varsity tennis, earning All-League recognition in second doubles as an eighth grader and playing first doubles as a freshman.

Christopher also excelled in the classroom, graduating third in his class with a 96.2 average. He earned numerous academic awards, including the Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute Medal for being the top student in mathematics and science and the Gould Award for the outstanding male graduate of his class.

Recruited for both cross country and track and field by coaches at several top academic institutions, Christopher chose to continue his athletic and academic success at Dartmouth College, an NCAA Division I institution and member of the Ivy League. At Dartmouth, he earned varsity letters in cross country, indoor track, and outdoor track. As a freshman, he qualified for the Pan Am Junior Championships in the 3000M steeplechase, posting the seventh fastest time in the nation for participants born in 1984 or later.

Christopher holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in Economics from Dartmouth College in Hanover, New Hampshire. He also earned a Master of Business Administration (MBA) degree from Fordham University in New York City, graduating with highest honors. Christopher lives and works in Manhattan, where he is employed by Crowe Horwath LLP, a business consulting and accounting firm.
