




HS/MS QUARTER I ACHIEVEMENT DATA








COLLEGE CREDIT BEARING COURSE UPDATE



2019-20 Course Enrollment Totals












DISTRICT READING DATA K-5





Grade 1 Instructional Reading Levels (DRA Fall)
