Proposition #1: 2019-2020 Budget

(306 +14) (55+17)

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Seneca Falls Central School District, Seneca County is hereby authorized to expend the sum of thirty million, five hundred fifty-seven thousand, six hundred forty-four dollars (\$30,557,644.00) in the 2019-2020 school year with such amount to be raised by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of such School District, after first deducting the monies available from State Aid and other sources as provided by law.

Proposition #2: Purchase Buses (3)

YES: 341 NO: 51

(320+20) (39+12)

Resolved, that the Board of Education of the Seneca Falls Central School District, Seneca County is hereby authorized to purchase two (2) 59 passenger school buses and two (2) passenger vans for the transportation of District students, for a sum of money not to exceed three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00); said amount to be expended in the 2019-2020 fiscal year; said sum or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be withdrawn from the District's "Capital Reserve Fund-Purchase of Buses", in accordance with the Education Law and Local Finance Law.

Proposition #3: Library Tax Increase

Shall the sum of two hundred ninety-two thousand dollars (\$292,000.00) be raised by annual levy of a tax upon the taxable property within the Seneca Falls Central School District for the purpose of funding the Seneca Falls Library?
